For 2023, we have some fantastic projects in the pipeline, like the repair work on the ferry Sébastien Vauban starting in early March, two barges of Vinci Construction Maritime et Fluvial scheduled for the dry dock in April and the dredgers *Cap d'Aunis* and *Hondarra*, which will be up on blocks this summer.
